2015 Class "D" Rules

- 1. All games start at 6:00 PM.
- 2. An official game is 5 innings. Any game called because of rain or darkness is official after 3-1/2 innings if the HOME team is winning. Otherwise, 4 complete innings must be played. If lightening occurs, games must be postponed immediately. No inning may be started after 1 hour and 45 minutes unless the game is tied.
- 3. Base distance is 60 feet. Pitching distance is 42 feet.
- 4. Stealing is permitted. Base runner's foot must remain on the base until the ball leaves the pitcher's hand. The runner may be picked off base by a throw from the catcher. The runner may advance only one base per time on base. No stealing of home is permitted at any time.
- 5. The catcher is not required to catch the third strike for the out.
- 6. Bunting is allowed.
- 7. If time-out is called, the return throw to the pitcher is a dead ball and no base runners may advance.
- 8. No infield fly rule. The ball must be caught for the out.
- 9. 9 players will be permitted to play in the field at one time, 6 infielders and 3 outfielders. No forfeits will be called due to lack of players, unless agreed upon by coaches.
- 10. Free substitution is permitted to keep players interested.
- 11. The batting order will consist of all players on the team. The batting order will be maintained; no batters will be permitted to bat out of order.
- 12. One half-inning will consist of 3 outs or 10 batters.
- 13. All players must bat, unless they are injured. If a player refuses to bat, he is considered an out, and will be out for the remainder of the game. If a player is injured and cannot bat, he will not be considered an out. (Coaches call)
- 14. No intentional collision with any fielders is permitted. Players must slide or they will be called out.
- 15. No pitcher shall appear in more than 3 innings in any game. (One batter is one inning.)
- 16. If a batter is hit by a pitch, he will be awarded first base. A ball that hits the ground first then hits the batter will be considered a hit by pitch.
- 17. When the 10th batter of the half inning comes to bat the team at bat will be considered to have 2 outs.
- 18. Shorts are NOT allowed. Long pants (sweats, blue jeans, baseball pants, etc.) are required for player's safety. Keep shirts tucked in.
- 19. The batter must maintain control of the bat at the plate. The umpire will issue 1 warning to the team for a thrown bat. Any subsequent infraction for that team is an automatic out for the batter.
- 20. On a groundball or pop fly that remains in the infield, the batter or base runners may advance not more than 1 base.
- 21. On a ball hit to the outfield, the runners may advance until the ball is in the infield. If the infielder continues the play, runners may advance.
- 22. A manager has the right to discipline players by sitting them on the bench for the rest of a game.
