2015 Pee-Wee Rules

- 1. All games start at 6:30 PM.
- 2. An official game is 5 innings. Any game called because of rain or darkness is official after 3-1/2 innings if the HOME team is winning. Otherwise, 4 complete innings must be played. If lightening occurs, games must be postponed immediately.
- 3. Base distance is 50 feet. No official pitching distance, but both coaches must pitch from the same distance.
- 4. The defensive pitcher must stand 6 feet behind the coach.
- 5. No stealing is permitted. No lead-offs are permitted. Runner must stay on base until the ball is hit by the batter.
- 6. The catcher is not required to catch the third strike for the out.
- 7. No pick off plays of any kind are permitted. The return throw to the pitcher is a dead ball. The base runners cannot advance and they cannot be tagged out.
- 8. No infield fly rule. The ball must be caught for the out.
- 9. More than 9 players will be permitted to play in the field at one time, 6 infielders and 4-5 outfielders. No forfeits will be called due to lack of players, unless agreed upon by coaches.
- 10. Free substitution is permitted to keep players interested.
- 11. The batting order will consist of all players on the team. The batting order will be maintained; no batters will be permitted to bat out of order.
- 12. One half-inning will consist of 3 outs or 10 batters, or once through the batting order if less than 10 players are present. No one will bat more than once in a half inning.
- 13. If a player refuses to bat, he will not be considered an out, but will count as one of the 10 batters for the half-inning.
- 14. No walks will be issued by the umpire. The batter must swing at the ball and miss for a strike to be called by the umpire.
- 15. When the last batter for the half inning comes to bat the team at bat will be considered to have 2 outs.
- 16. Three coaches will be permitted on the field for defensive instruction.
- 17. The batter and base runners can only advance one base on a ball that first lands in the infield, even if it rolls into the outfield. The batter and the base runners can only advance one or two bases on a ball that lands in the outfield. All runners advance "at their own risk"; they must safely reach base. There is no intention to automatically award bases to any batter or base runner.
- 18. Shorts are NOT allowed. Long pants (sweats, blue jeans, baseball pants, etc.) are required for player's safety.
- 19. The coaches are required to pitch to the batter using an overhand motion.
- 20. The batter must maintain control of the bat at the plate. The umpire will issue 1 warning to the team for a thrown bat. Any subsequent infraction for that team is an automatic out for the batter.
- 21. Sliding is not allowed. The umpire will issue 1 warning to the team for sliding. Any subsequent infraction for that team is an automatic out for the runner.
